  - 2. Employment ✓
  - 3. Dismissal
  - 4. Discipline
  - 5. Promotion
  - 6. Demotion
  - 7. Compensation ✓
  - 8. Investigation of charges/complaints (unless public hearing requested)
- B. To consider the purchase of property for the public purposes or for the sale of property at competitive bidding
- C. Conferences with an attorney for the public body concerning disputes involving the public body that are the subject of pending or imminent court action
- D. Preparing for, conducting or reviewing negotiations or bargaining sessions with public employees concerning their compensation or other terms and conditions of their employment.
- E. Matters required to be kept confidential by federal law or rules or state statutes

- F. Specialized details of security arrangements where disclosure of the matters discussed might reveal information that could be used for the purpose of committing or avoiding prosecution for a violation of the law

**IV. Administrative Discussion Items, Presentations, and Updates**

**A. Delayed Start Time Committee Community Meeting on January 13, 2016:** This past April, our district formed a Delayed Start Time Committee to explore the idea of delaying the start time of the school day for middle and high school students based upon the medical research on the sleep patterns of adolescents. The goal of our district's Delayed Start Time Committee is to provide a recommendation on how to proceed to our Board of Education by June 2016. Our [Strategic Plan 2016-2020](#) calls for our Board of Education to discuss the committee's recommendation and make a final decision by December 2016. The Delayed Start Time Committee has reached the point in their work where they believe an opportunity for community education on the topic, and additional input from community members, is desired. They plan to use input from community members in their discussions as a recommendation to the board is formalized (you can view past Delayed Start Time Committee meeting minutes by clicking [here](#)).

You are invited to attend a community education presentation on the topic of delaying the start of the school day by 30 minutes (and, as a result, the end of the school day by 30 minutes as well). The presentation will take place on Wednesday, January 13, at 6:30 p.m., in the James R. McIlvaine Performing Arts Center at Wadsworth High School.

The presentation will include an overview of the research on adolescent sleep patterns by Dr. Wendy K. Bedrosian, a professor in the Teaching, Learning and Curriculum Studies Department at Kent State University. Members of the Delayed Start Time Committee will also outline what implementation of the delayed start concept would look like in Wadsworth. As the committee has worked through logistical details, it has become apparent for many reasons (which will be discussed at the meeting) that implementing a delayed start in Wadsworth will impact the start/end time of school for all students, grades Pre-K-12. There will be an opportunity to ask questions at the meeting as well as plenty of opportunities to provide feedback (both written and oral) after the meeting and throughout the remainder of January.
