What is “RtI” (Response to Intervention) and how is it a part of the Multifactorial Evaluation?

“RtI” is “Response to Intervention.” Each school district is required to provide research based interventions for students who are not experiencing success with grade level standards. These interventions, usually provided by the classroom teacher or support personnel, are generally implemented prior to a student being referred for a multifactorial evaluation. School personnel will collect data as to how your child responds to this research based intervention. If the intervention is successful, a referral for the multifactorial evaluation may not be necessary.
