



## Wadsworth City Schools Two-Hour Delay for Students



Wadsworth City Schools will utilize a “Two-Hour Delay for Students” during the 2014-15 school year when needed due to inclement weather.

The following is what a two-hour delay will entail:

1. Parents will get a phone call from the AlertNow phone calling system announcing a “Two-Hour Delay for Students.” Notification of a “Two-Hour Delay for Students” will also be posted on the district website, WCTV Channel 16, local television stations, Facebook and Twitter.
2. Buses/vehicles will run their regular routes, two hours later (including non-public and special education).
3. Students who utilize bus transportation will still need to get on their assigned bus at their assigned bus stop, two hours later.
4. Parents/students will be responsible to find alternative transportation to school if students will not be at their regularly assigned bus stop.
5. Breakfast will not be available to students due to the later start time.
6. Students will still have a lunch period scheduled into their day.
7. Students will have an abbreviated class schedule and dismissal will be at the regular time.
8. Bear Cub Academy will still be open at 6:30 a.m. and will keep all *registered* students for the extra two hours at the regular hourly rate.
9. If parents choose not to send their child to school, or cannot transport their child to school, they need to call the building attendance line in order for the day to be an excused absence.
10. Scheduled after school events will be held as planned.
11. School will dismiss at normal times.

Preschool, A.M. - Cancelled

Preschool, P.M. - No Change. Program will run on regular schedule with bus pickup at normal times.
